MOTION:

Vice-Chairman Johnson moved to approve the Consent Agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lann and approved 3-0.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Tender Purchase: Chief Van der Veen provided information regarding a tender purchase opportunity. Hughes Fire Equipment Inc. has a demo Pierce tender available at a reduced cost. The apparatus is similar to the recently purchased District 21 unit. A copy of the agreement was included in the Board packet and sent to the attorney for review. If the Board moves forward with

the purchase, the 1999 tender currently stationed at Britton Loop Station 12 would replace an older tender housed in District 21's response area.

Chief Van der Veen and Chairman Cooley agreed to meet to review budget implications and ensure the other planned projects for 2025 can still be completed (engine purchase and siding project). A recommendation will be provided at the February meeting.

Fire Engine Purchase: Chief Van der Veen noted the apparatus spec committee and sales representative will meet the week of January 20 to review the engine bid. Payment will not be due until between 18-24 months. More information is expected during the February meeting.

Britton Loop Station 12 Exterior Project: Chief Van der Veen has met with one contractor regarding the siding project. The contractor recommended that the project be completed in May or June and that the siding be painted on-site for longer-lasting results. Additional concerns were identified, including portions of the roof sliding and gutter issues that will need to be corrected. In addition, it was recommended that additional trees be removed. Chief Van der Veen will investigate.

Once two more bids have been obtained, the project can move forward.

Resolution 2025-01 Establishing 2025 Meeting Dates and Times: Chairman Cooley reviewed a portion of the resolution.
